- It will also highlight some issues and challenges



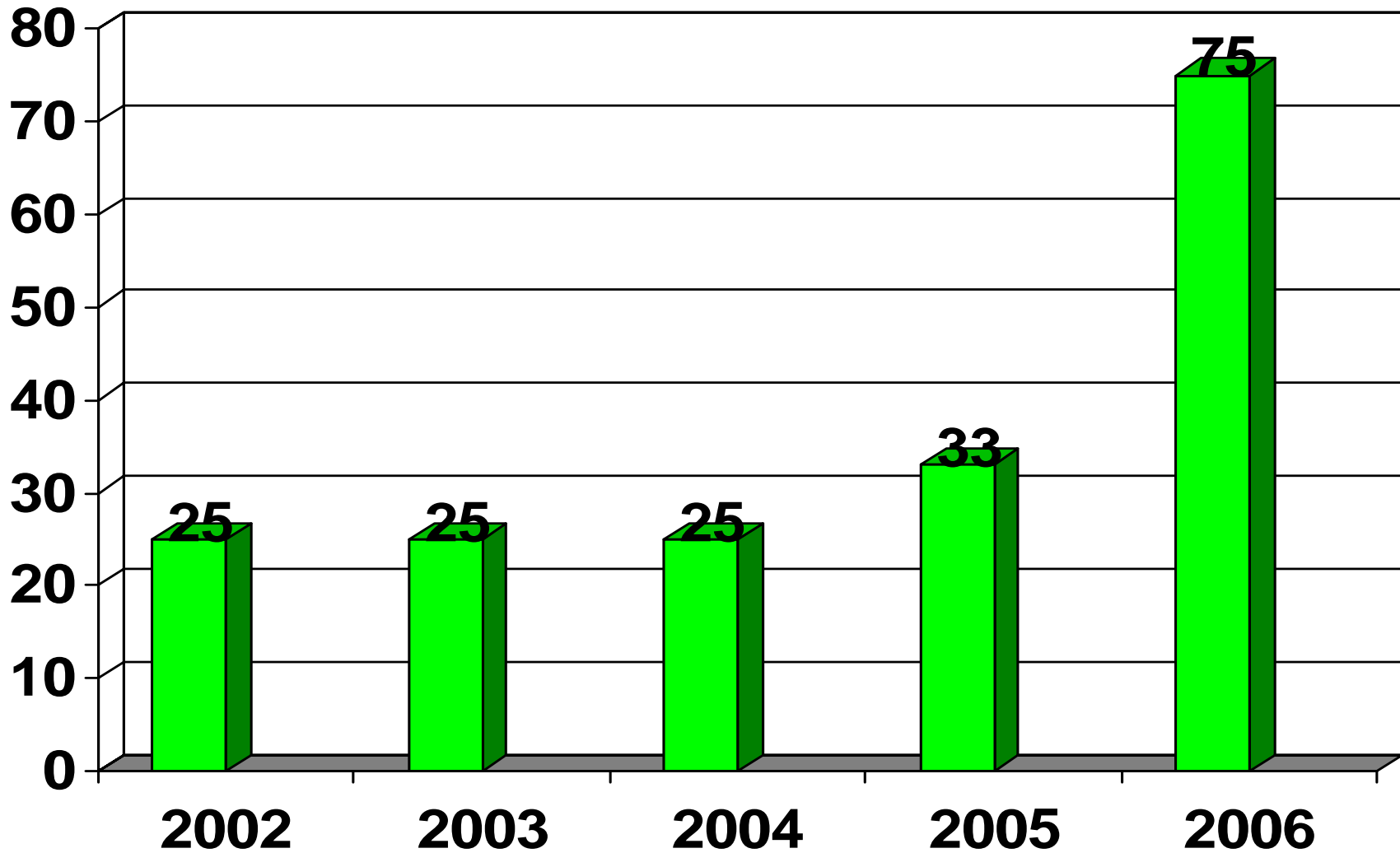

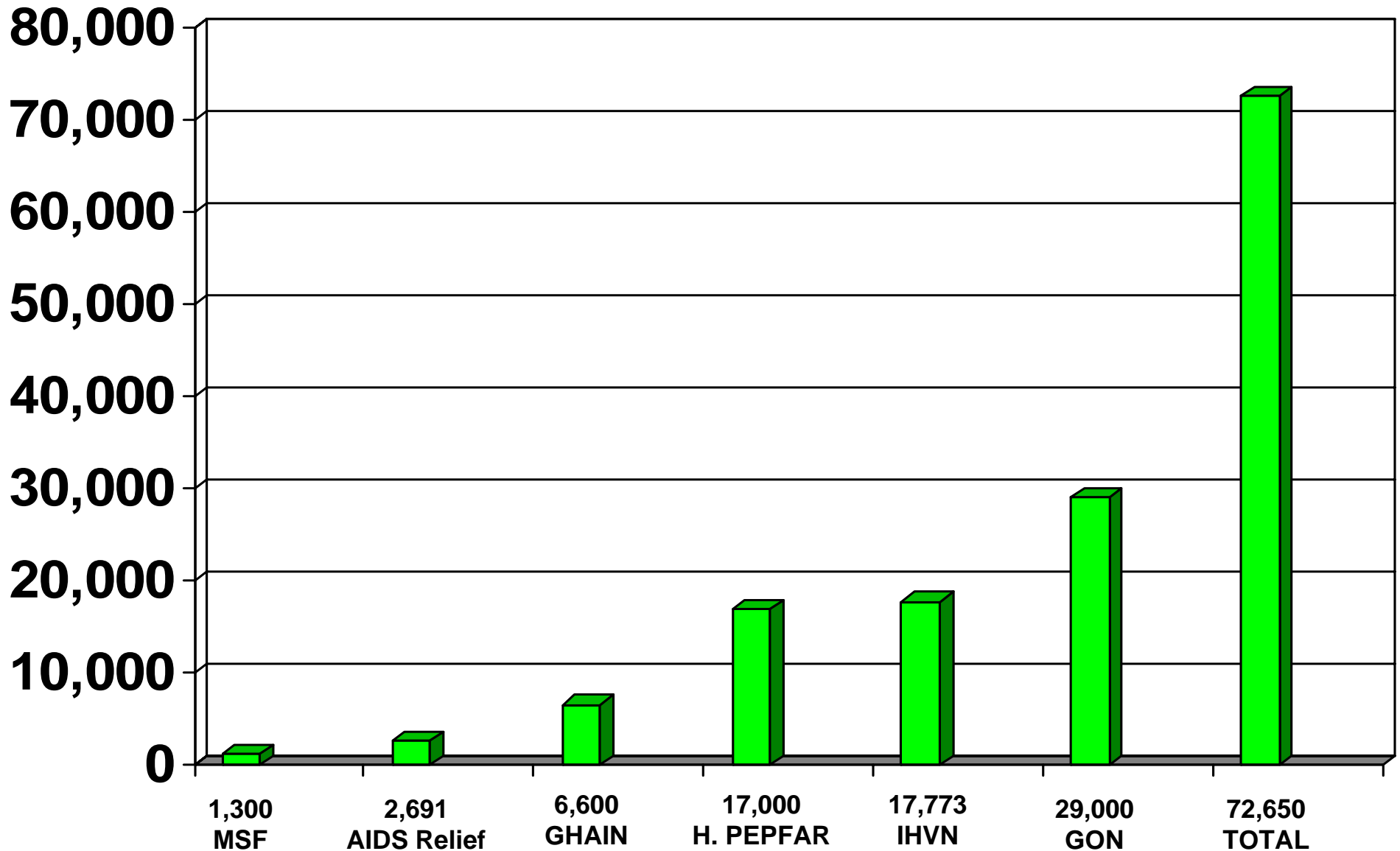


# Number of ART Sites 2002-2006



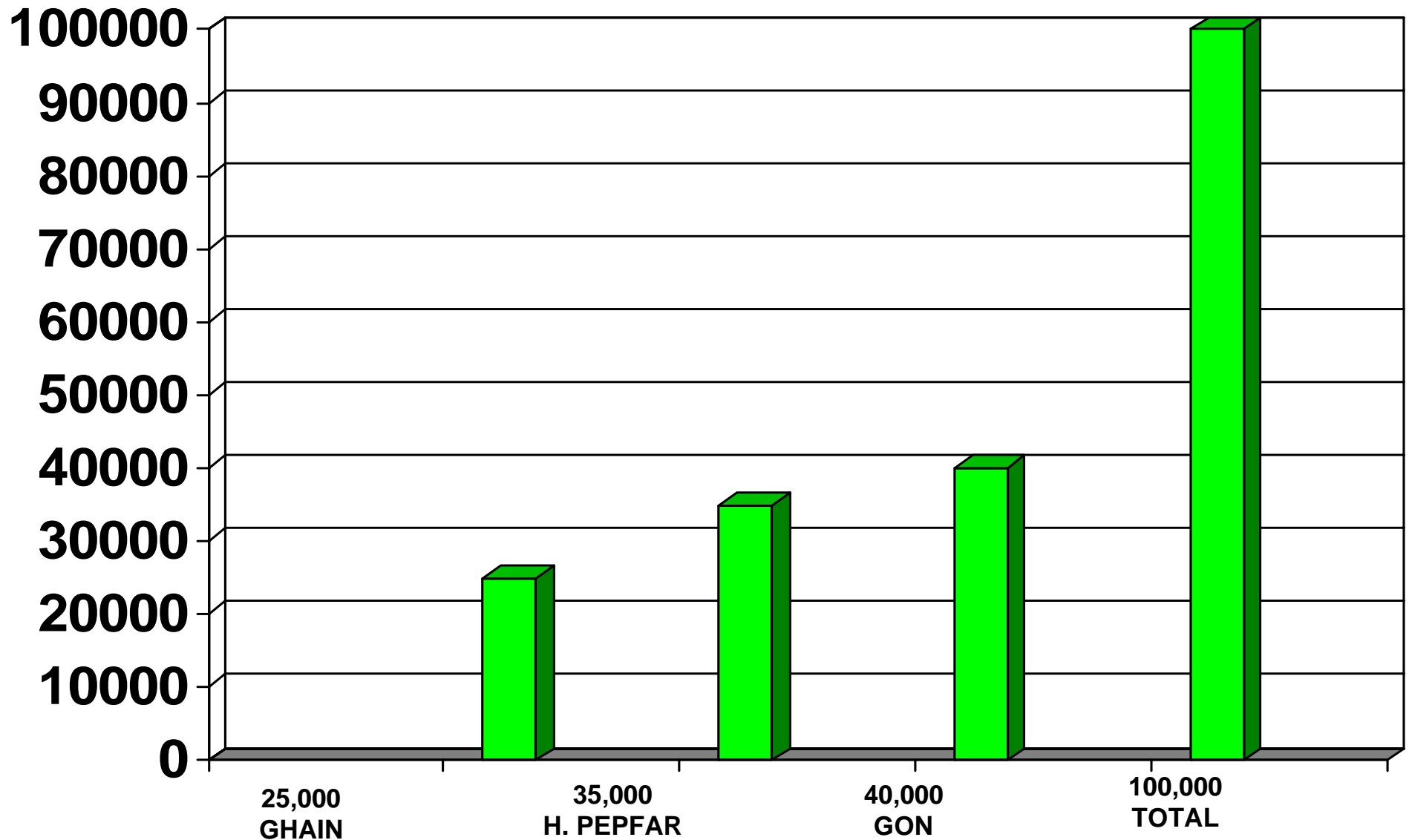


# Number of Patients on ART 2002-2006



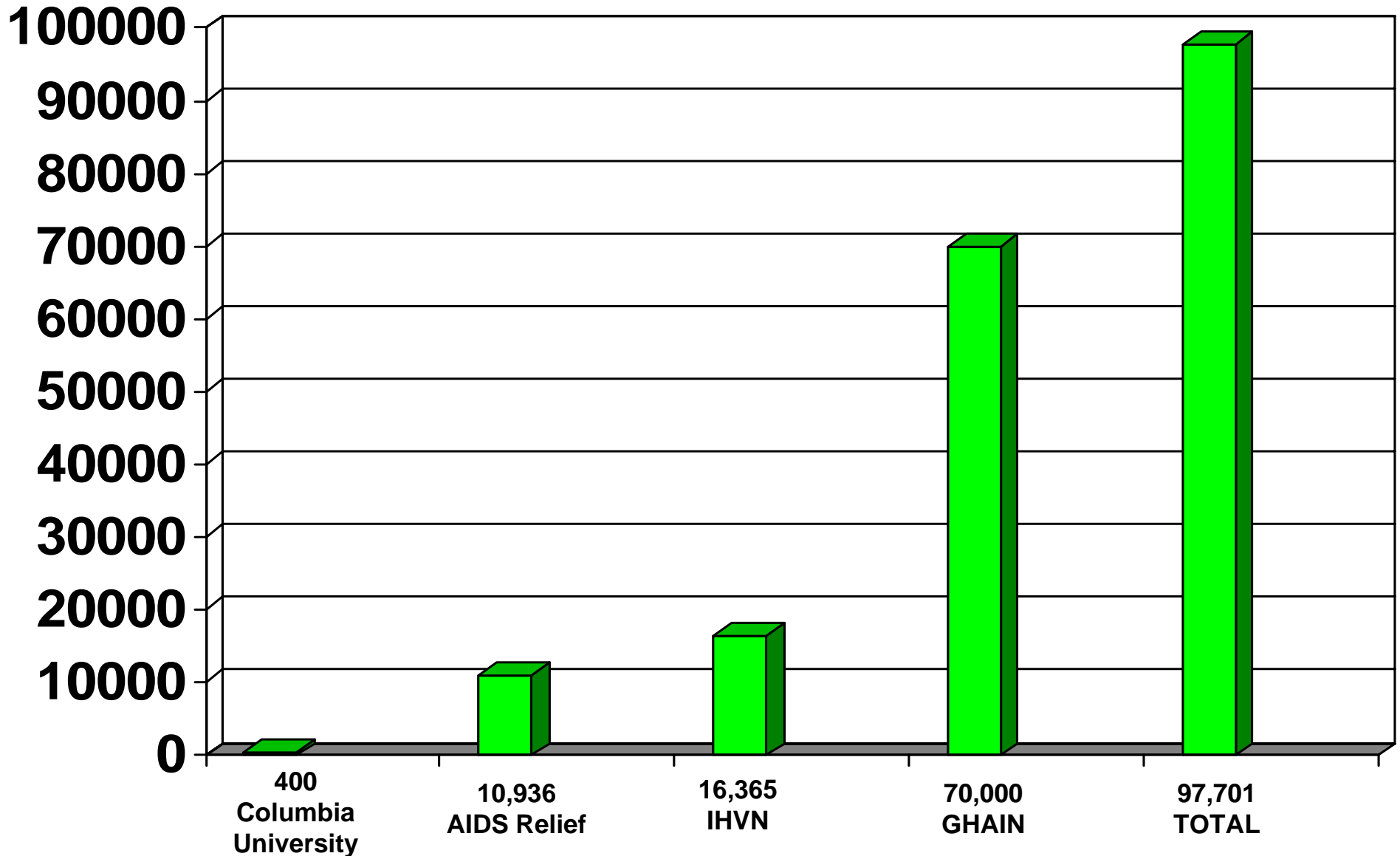


# Number of Persons Accessing PMTCT June 2006



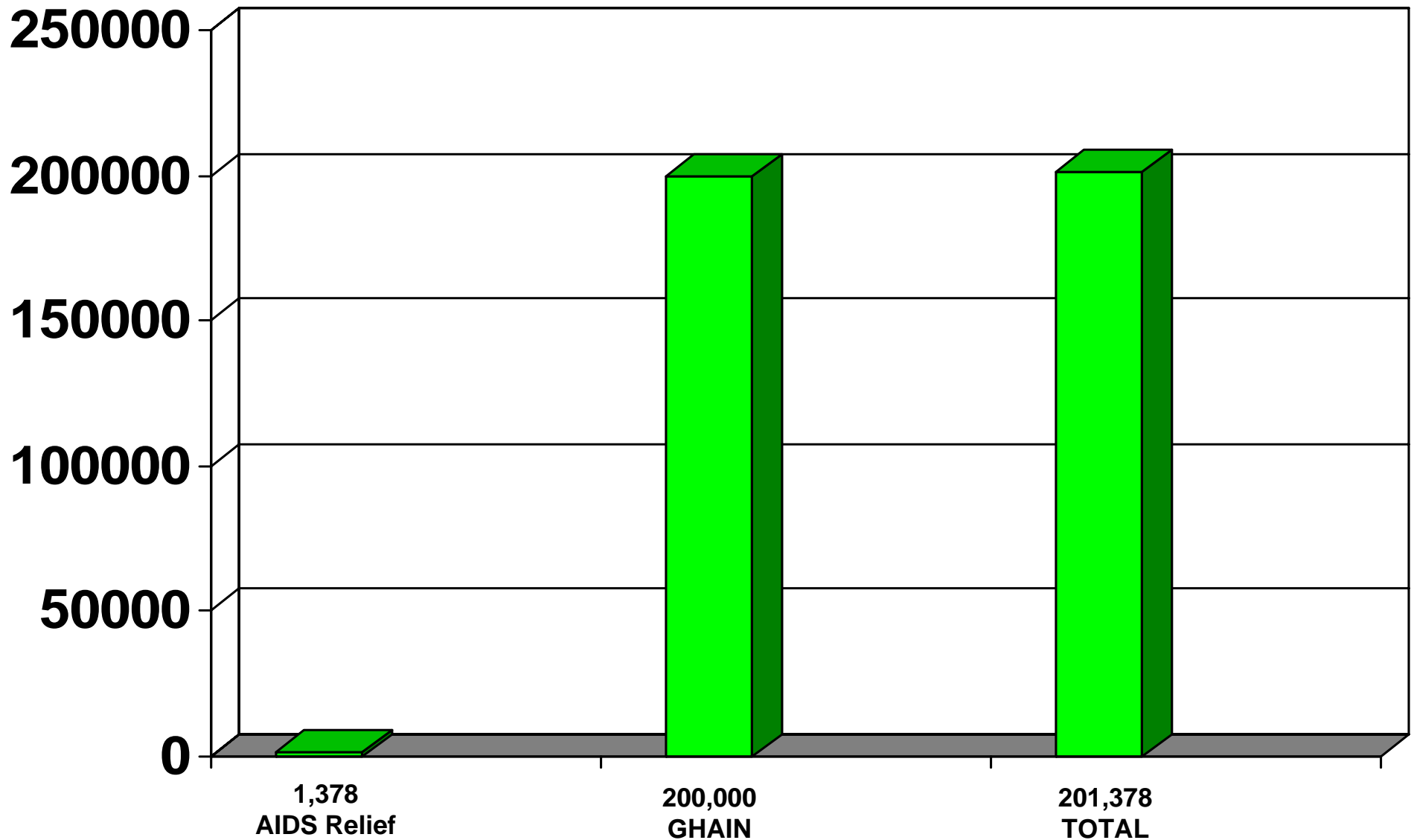


# Number of Persons receiving Palliative Care June 2006



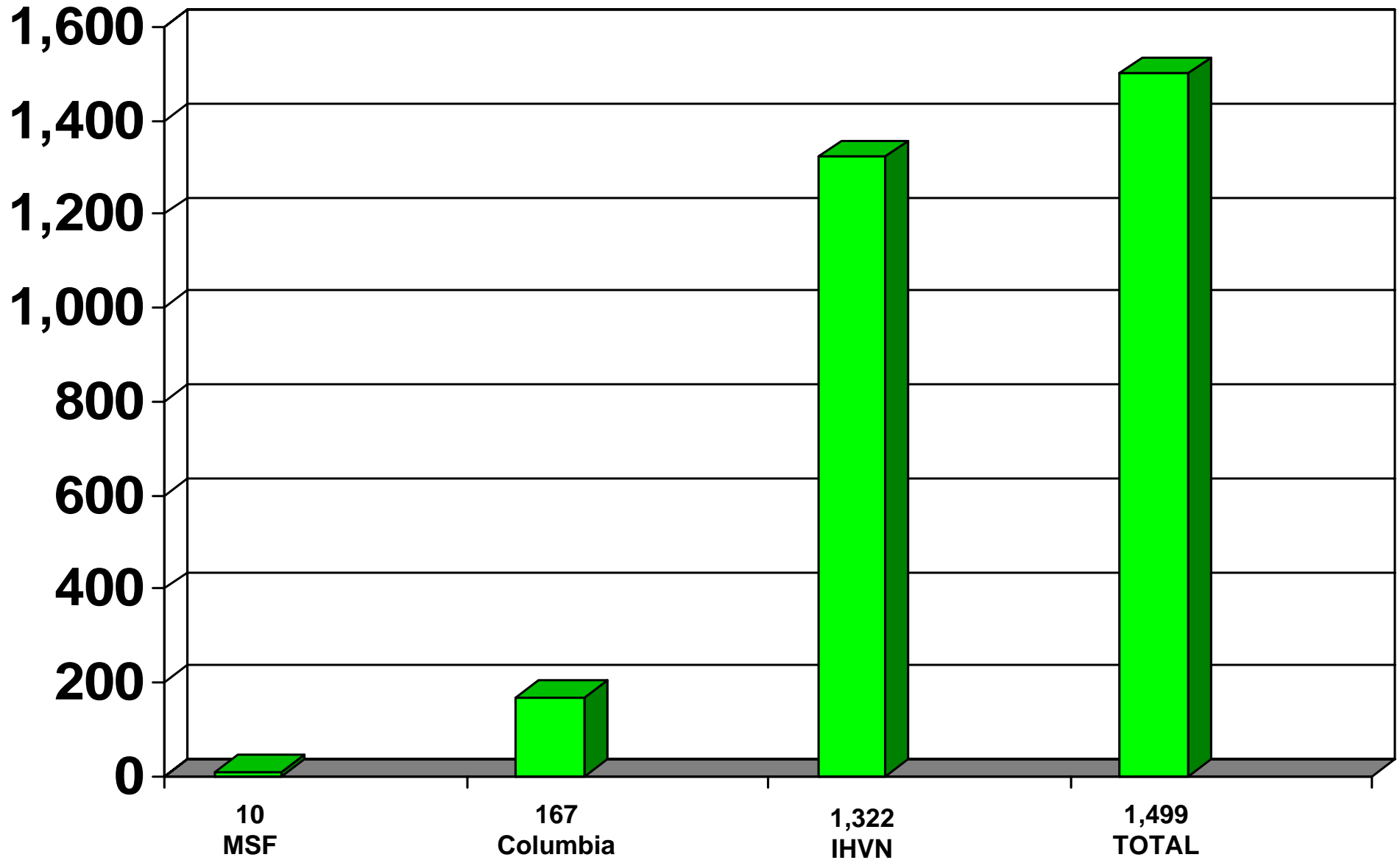


# Number of Persons Accessing VCT June 2006





# Number of Health Workers Trained June 2006



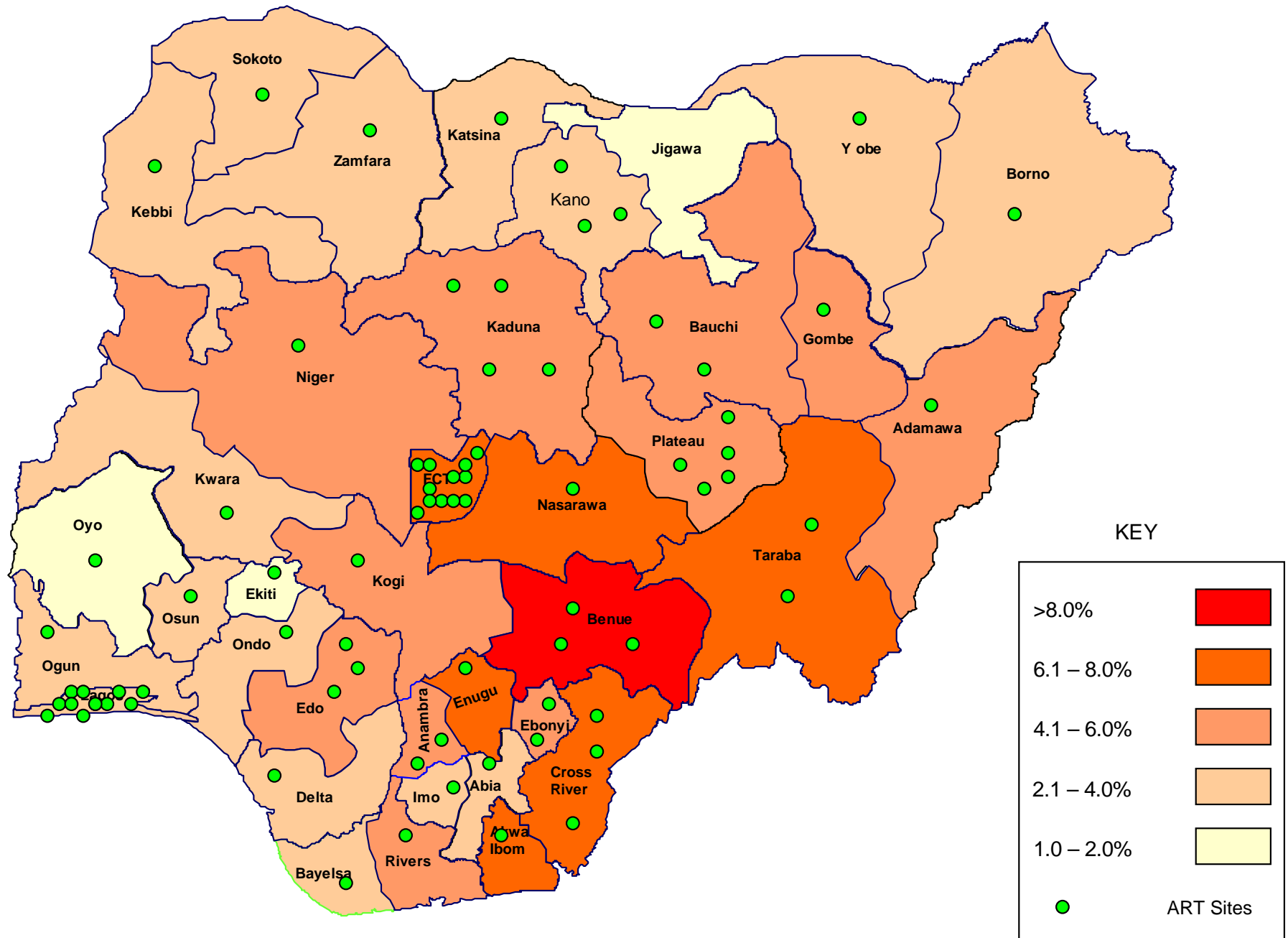


# Issues



- Over-concentration of partners activities at some sites
- Increasing resistance – need for regional viral load testing facilities
- Need for operational guidelines for partners

# Challenges



- Poor Infrastructure
  - Non-availability of functional structures
  - Unstable power
  - Equipment maintenance
- Lack of a unified national identity system for patients on ARVS for patient tracking
- Adherence – need for adherence counseling
- Low human capacity – especially at secondary and primary levels



# Way Forward



- NASCP to meet with relevant partners quarterly
- All Partners to submit report to NASCP monthly
- Showcase best practices
- Build partnerships
